Konza was awarded the 2023 Business Excellence Award from the Junction City Area Chamber of Commerce.



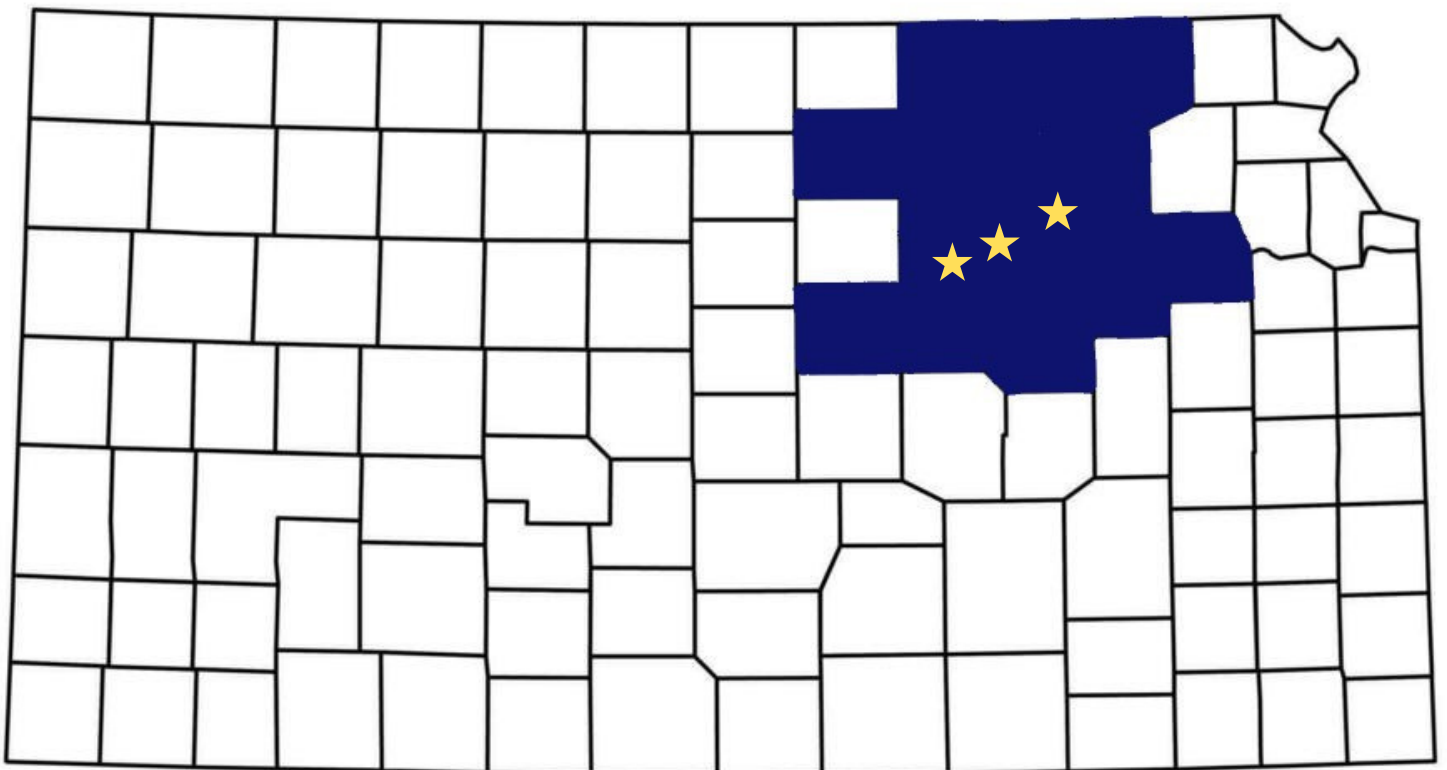

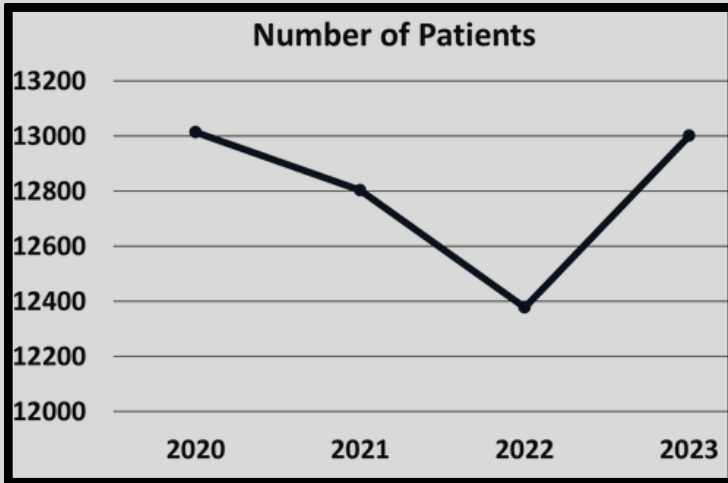

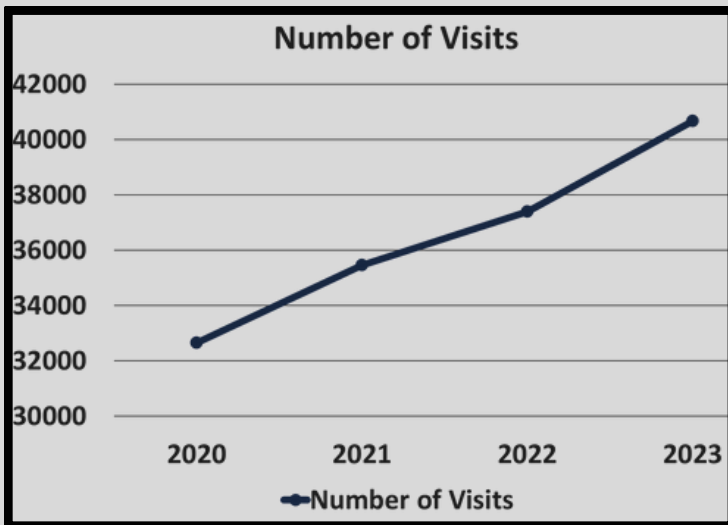

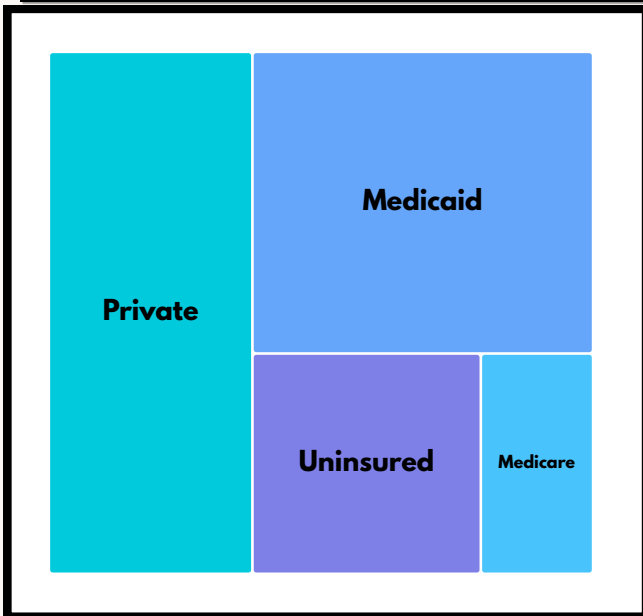

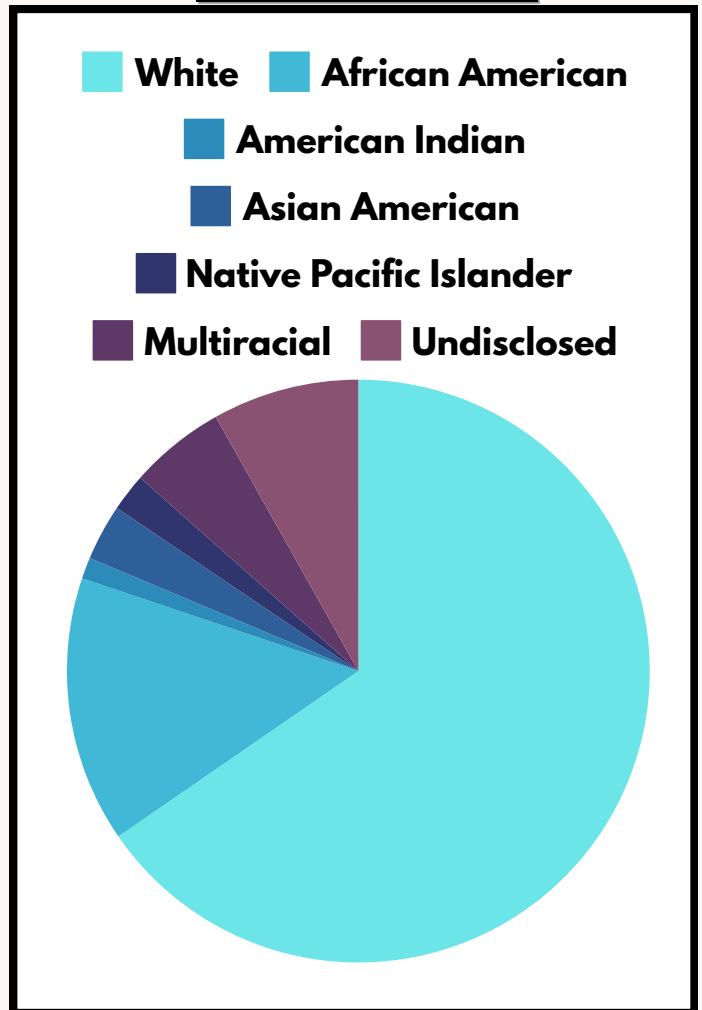

DEMOGRAPHICS AND POPULATIONS SERVED

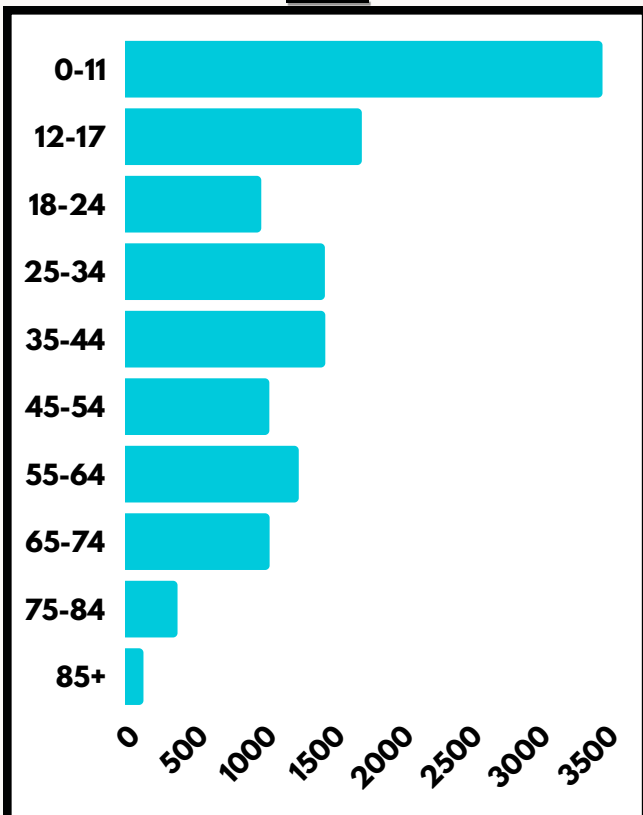
PATIENTS BY INSURANCE TYPE



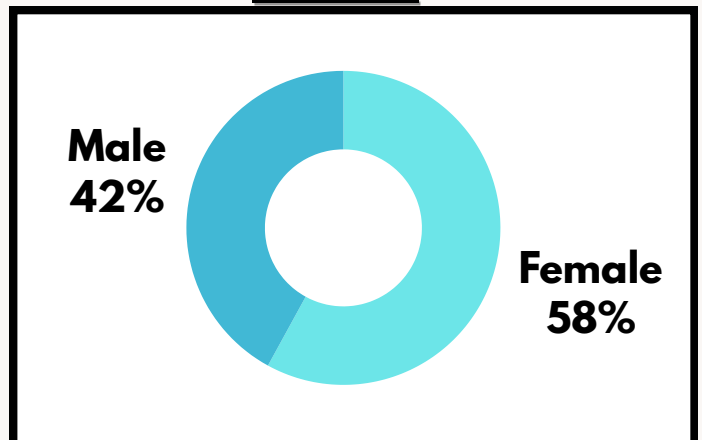
RACE/ETHNICITY
